The aim of Colchester Credit Union is to encourage its members to save regularly and provide loans at affordable rates of interest.

Colchester Credit Union is a non-profit-making money cooperative, run by volunteers and managed by its members to provide local ethical banking.

WHAT SERVICES DO CREDIT UNIONS OFFER?

Colchester Credit Union offers savings accounts and affordable loans.

Savings Accounts

- Savings can be of any amount up to £15,000
- You can withdraw your funds when you need to (notice may be needed)
- You have the flexibility to save how much you like when you like

Loans

- You can apply for a loan after you have been making regular savings
 - There are no set up fees and no penalties for early repayment
 - Loans are available for over 18s only
